Concurring Statement to "Name of a Convert" Rabbi Gail Labovitz YD 269:1.2010d

This paper was submitted in January 2011 as a concurrence to "Name of a Convert" by Rabbi Barry Leff. Concurring and dissenting opinions are not official positions of the Committee on Jewish Law and Standards.

In point 2) of the "P'sak Din" on p. 5, Rabbi Leff writes: "If a convert chooses a different name, it is preferred that in any official documents, such as ketubbot or gittin, that the convert be identified as הגיורת." Based on the sources that Rabbi Leff himself brings, I would say that the word "preferred" should be replaced by the word "required."
