DUES REGULATIONS

- 1. All Rabbinical Assembly members are expected to fulfill dues requirements of the Assembly.
- 2. Members shall determine the amount of their annual assessment in accordance with the schedule which the Executive Council shall fix from time to time. Members must report the amount of their assessment at the beginning of each fiscal year but no later than November 1st of that year. Dues must be remitted no later than November 1st of that fiscal year. The Treasurer or Financial Secretary, in consultation with the Chief Executive, shall have the power to waive the whole or part of dues for any member or grant an extension of payment. Dues reduction applications must be submitted and approved annually. Please contact the Accounting office to request a form.
- 3. Dues must be calculated on the sum of your compensation (less medical benefits and pension contributions), which includes salary and housing allowance (or rental value of parsonage).
- 4. Rabbinical Assembly minimum dues are \$300.
- 5. A retired rabbi will be expected to pay dues, according to the graduated scale, based on the amount of the rabbi's retirement income.
- 6. Rabbis ordained fifty years or more are exempt from dues.
- 7. If your position is not in the congregational rabbinate, you may deduct dues paid to one primary professional organization (Hillel Directors, etc.) from your dues assessment. However, **minimum dues of \$300** is required of all Rabbinical Assembly members, unless other arrangements are made with the Financial Secretary or the Chief Executive.
- 8. Rabbinical Assembly members who are permanent residents of Israel or Latin America will pay dues in accordance with the structure determined by their respective Region. All other Regions pay dues to the Rabbinical Assembly office in New York.
- 9. Members on Sabbatical leave living in Israel should continue to make their payments to the Rabbinical Assembly office in New York. Members from Israel or Latin America working in the United States are expected to remit dues to the United States based upon the regular dues schedule.
- 10. Members who have failed to report and/or remit the amount of the assessment within the above time frames without the express approval of the Treasurer or Financial Secretary may be suspended or expelled from membership by action of the Executive Council.
